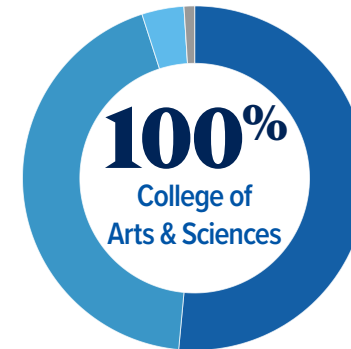

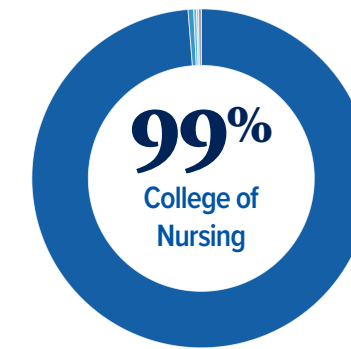

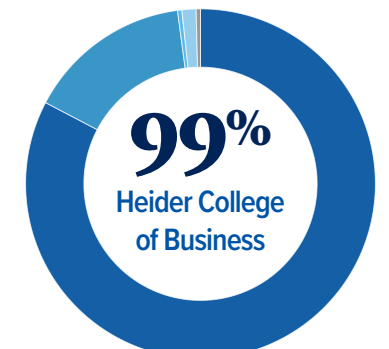

ONE-OF-A-KIND GLOBAL SCHOLARS

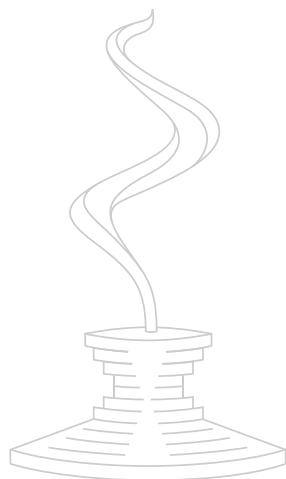

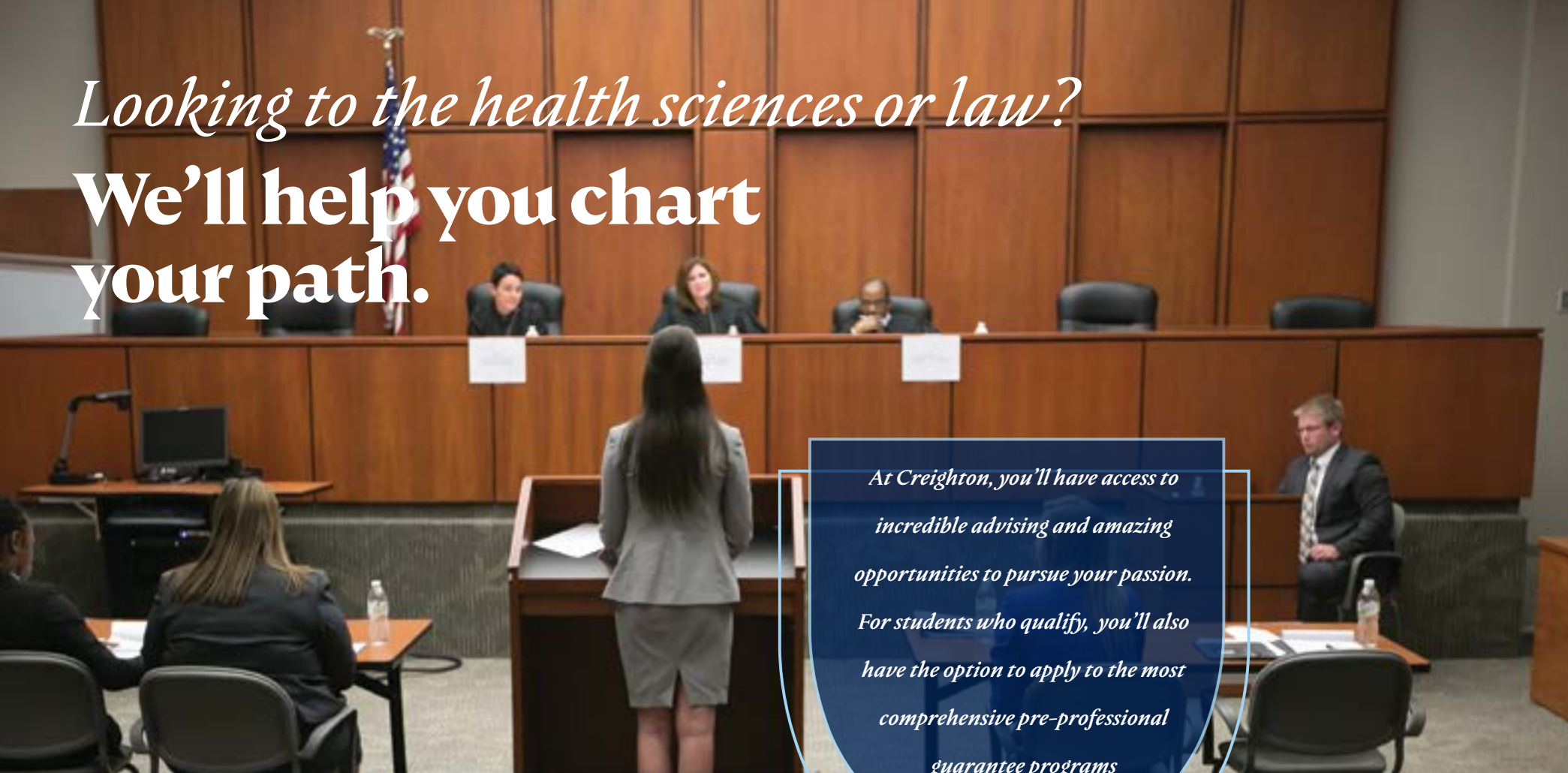

COMPETITIVE SPECIAL PROGRAMS

CREIGHTON PRE-PROFESSIONAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM (CPPSP) – Because more than half of our students come to Creighton with the goal of pursuing a professional degree, we have created the country's most comprehensive, intentional pre-professional advising and guarantee program in Dental, Law, Medical, Occupational Therapy, Pharmacy, and Physical Therapy Programs.

FRESHMAN LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (FLP) – As part of FLP, you will live and learn in community, bringing your experience and passions together, to create a close-knit group dedicated to community service, leadership, peer mentoring and academics. You will be challenged to grow as a leader and to implement your leadership skills across campus and in the Omaha community.

GLOBAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM – Participants in the Global Scholars Program will complete a minimum of four global experiences, as well as a special companion seminar each semester to integrate global learning into their major. These experiences are designed to immerse you in a diverse mix of cultures, experiences and traditions that provide a rich, well-traveled lens through which to focus your major studies.

HADDIX DEAN'S FELLOWS PROGRAM – Work closely with the dean of the College of Arts and Sciences in this four-year leadership program, building connections and developing your own leadership skills through experiential learning. FOCUSED ON THE FUTURE

Arts and Sciences students learn how to approach the world around us from many angles: with the creativity fostered in the arts, critical thinking in natural sciences, ethical principles and strong communications in the humanities, and the commitment to social justice nurtured in the social sciences. Our students are prepared for the dynamic work environments of tomorrow, making them “robot-proof.”

You’ll work side by side with your professors to push thinking even further. In the College of Arts and Sciences, 43% of students participated in research last year, with 52% completing an internship. That hands-on experience will help you connect the classroom to the real world.



SEE THE WORLD

Immerse yourself in the culture and traditions of another country. Arts and Sciences students study on every continent except Antarctica. Each year, faculty lead summer courses to over 15 different countries.

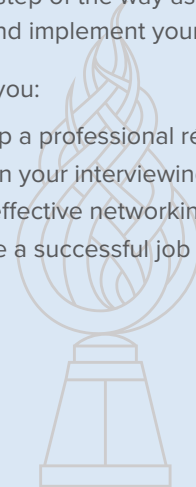

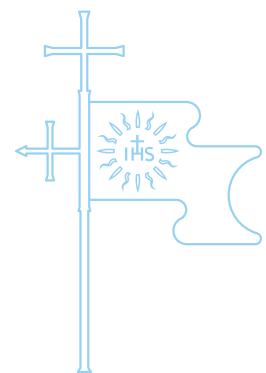
92% PASS RATE

INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

Creighton is well-known for innovative programs that keep pace with the ever-changing field of nursing. Our traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) will prepare you for entry-level professional nursing practice in both hospital and community-based settings.

At Creighton, you'll complete a semester-long preceptorship, where you will work side-by-side with a BSN-prepared nurse. It's essentially reverse job shadowing: You perform the nursing duties, but with your preceptor as a backup and resource. During this time, you'll analyze clinical challenges, pose solutions and put what you've learned into action.

Most summer nursing internships are paid positions and provide an excellent opportunity for students to gain invaluable experience in a number of clinical settings. These internships also provide connections for employment after graduation.

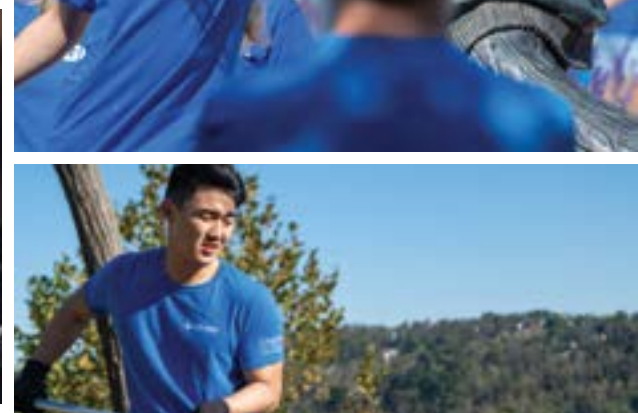
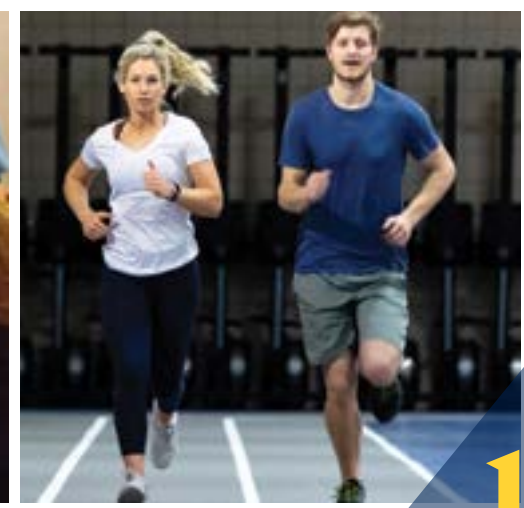
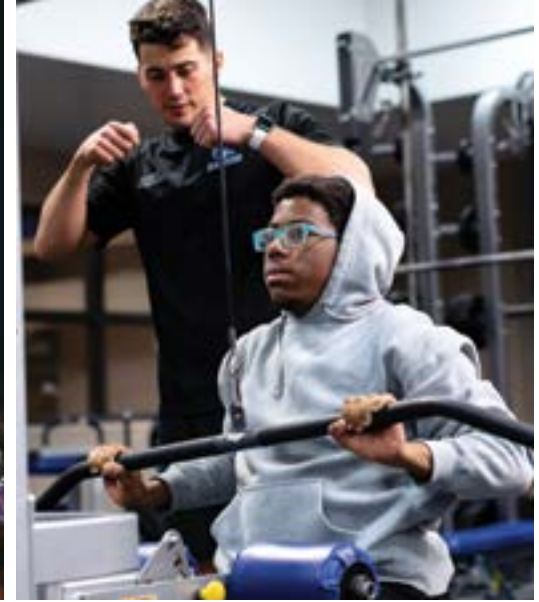

Freshman Leadership Program (FLP)

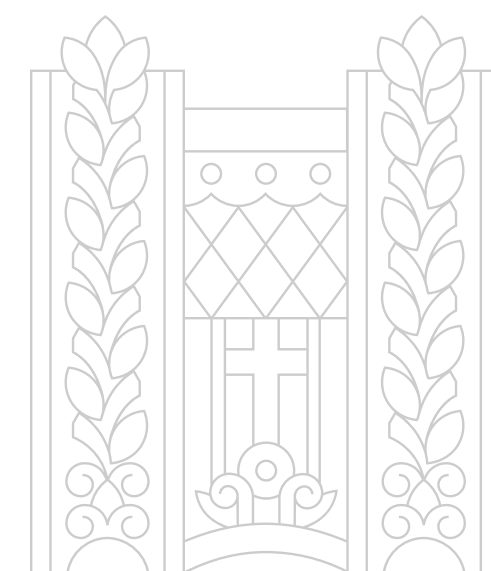

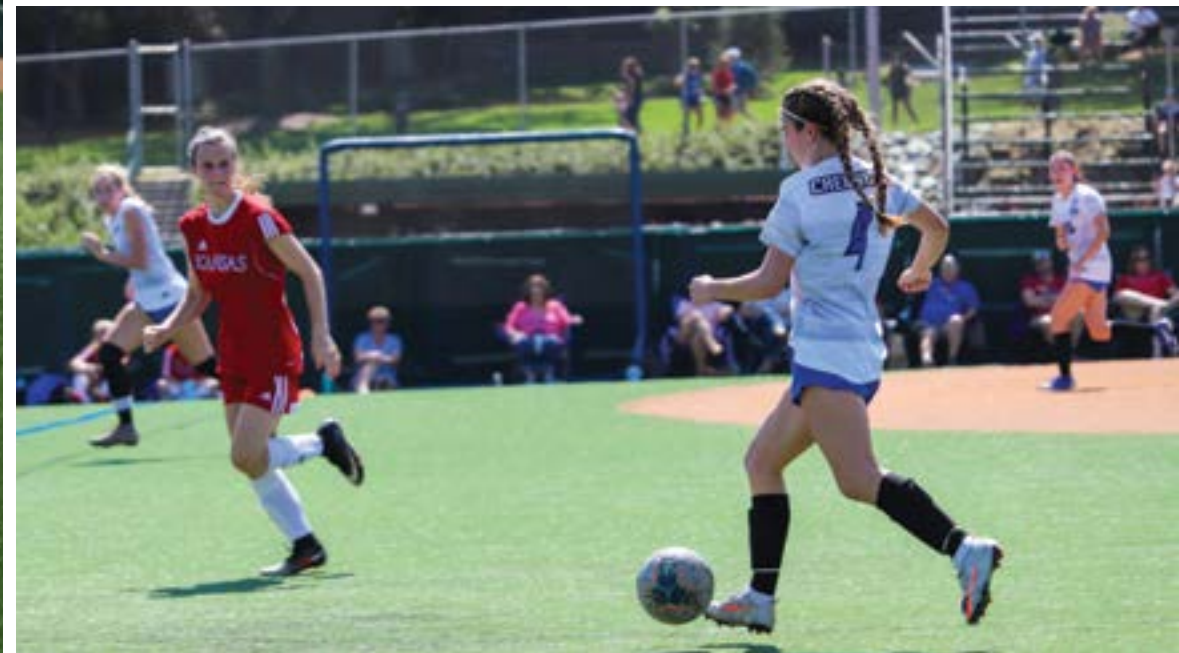
