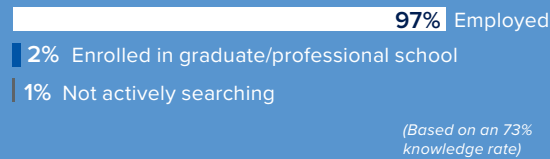

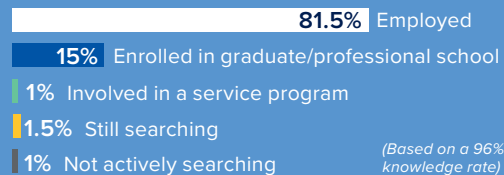

# Apply today!

It is easy to apply for admission at [creighton.edu/application](https://creighton.edu/application) or via the Common Application at [commonapp.org](https://commonapp.org). By completing the Application for Admission, you receive automatic consideration for Academic Merit Awards. We use the information in your admissions file to match you with appropriate scholarships.

Our non-binding early action deadline of **November 1** means that all applications submitted and completed by this date will receive an admissions decision by **December 15**. All other admission decisions occur on a rolling basis after early application decisions.

To receive priority consideration for admission and scholarships, the Application for Undergraduate Admission and all required credentials must be received by the Office of Admissions by **December 1**. After December 1, scholarships will be awarded based on the availability of funds.

## REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

- **Completed application for admission**
- **Personal statement/essay**
- **Official transcripts and grading scale** (*sent directly from your high school*)
  - Transfer students must also include transcripts from all colleges or universities attended.
- **High school counselor evaluation**
  - Transfer students must submit a college official's report to confirm good standing at their previous institution(s).
- **ACT or SAT I scores\***
  - For students submitting test scores, writing scores are not required for ACT/SAT.
- **Teacher recommendation(s)**
  - Optional—may be teacher, mentor, advisor, etc.

## SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Ninety-two percent of our students receive some form of the following types of aid:

- Need-based financial aid—scholarships, grants, loans, work study
- Non-need-based aid—academic merit scholarships and loans
- Athletic scholarships
- ROTC scholarships



SCAN TO APPLY

\*Creighton is a test-optional institution. Applicants who feel their ACT or SAT score does not accurately reflect their ability to be successful at Creighton may elect to apply test-optional.

## Application Timeline

### NOVEMBER 1

Early action deadline. This non-binding deadline means that applications submitted and completed by November 1 will be reviewed first and receive an admissions decision by **December 15**.

### DECEMBER 1

Priority deadline for admission and scholarship consideration. To be eligible for maximum scholarship consideration, the completed Application for Admission, including all required materials, must be received in the Admissions Office no later than **December 1**. Admission decisions occur on a rolling basis. Notification comes 4–6 weeks after completing your application.

### JANUARY 10

Completed additional scholarship and special program application deadline. You can find additional scholarship applications in your student portal at [choose.creighton.edu/status](https://choose.creighton.edu/status).

### FEBRUARY 1

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) **Preferred Deadline** to be considered for the maximum amount of need-based aid (Creighton, federal, state and private.)

### MAY 1

Class reservation, housing contract, and deposit deadline. Complete your class reservation form at [choose.creighton.edu/status](https://choose.creighton.edu/status).
